As the return of Jesus draws near, spiritual growth should be our priority. Are you growing?


II. We Should Worship Jesus Because He Has Promised to Return vv. 8-11.

7 "And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book." ⁸ I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me, ⁹ but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

II. We Should Worship Jesus Because He Has Promised to Return vv. 8-11.



III. We Should Evangelize the Lost Because Jesus Has Promised to Return vv. 12-19.



¹⁵ Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and the sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

III. We Should Evangelize the Lost Because Jesus Has Promised to Return vv. 12-19.



III. We Should Evangelize the Lost Because Jesus Has Promised to Return vv. 12-19.

¹⁸ I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book, ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.

IV. We Should Stay Ready Because He Could Come at Any Time vv. 20-21.

²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! ²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.

- The imminent return of Christ should motivate us to <u>gather</u> for worship, <u>grow</u> as disciples, and <u>go</u> as witnesses.
- These should be our priorities!
