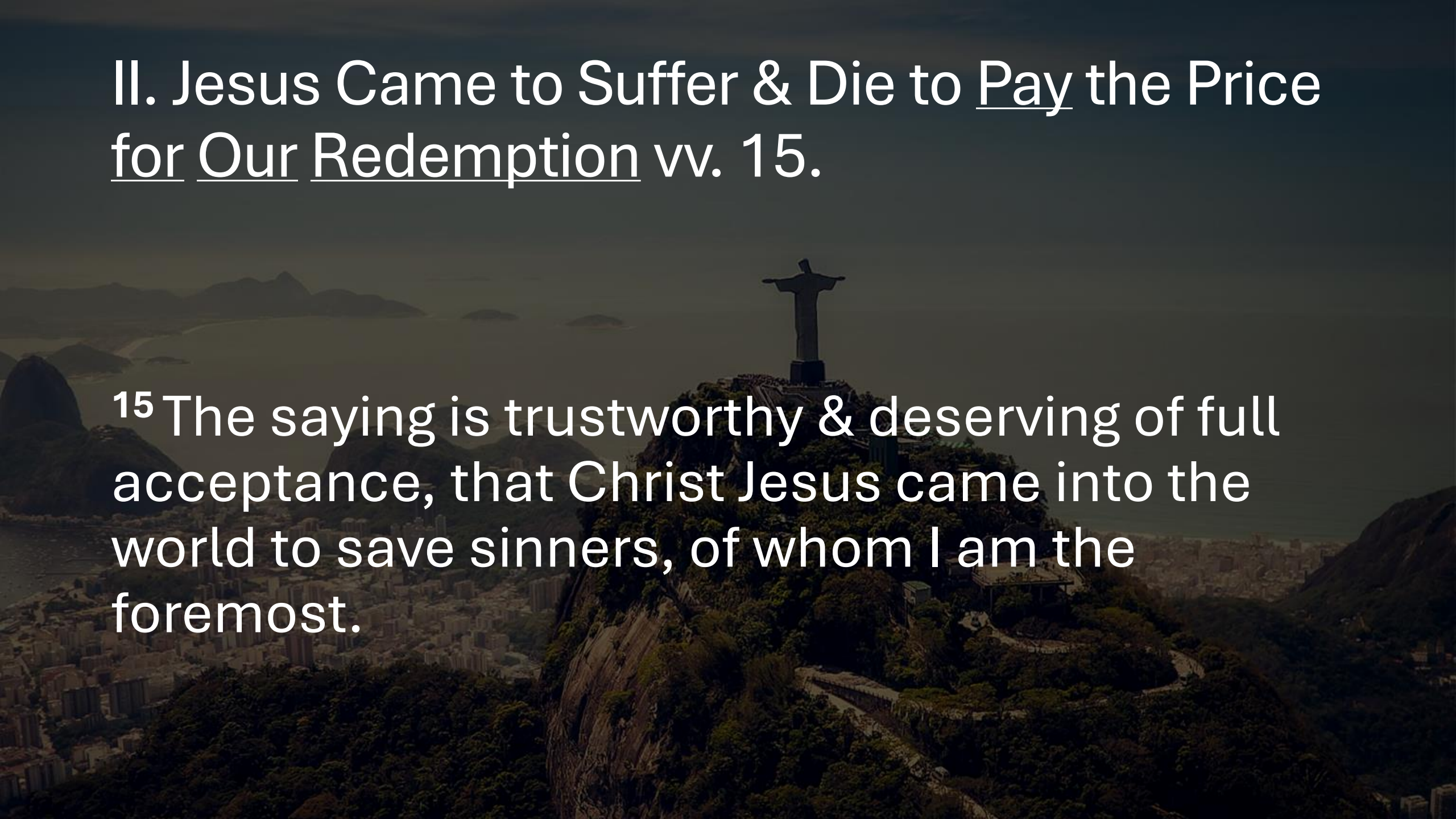
Mercy is when we deserve punishment but do not receive it. Grace is when we receive good things even though we do not deserve them.




Because Jesus is so

II. Jesus Came to Suffer & Die to Pay the Price for Our Redemption vv. 15.


A. Paul is emphatic, Jesus came to this earth to save sinners (Rom. 3:23; 6:23; 5:8)!

B. On the cross Jesus paid for our sin debt so that we could be saved.

C. Jesus came to save us because we are unable to save ourselves.
